

Cut (4,4,4,4) 6-1/2" VERTICAL Stripes centering ornaments				
Cut (1,2,2,2) 2-1/2" VERTICAL Stripes centering roses, into (20,35,63,81) 2-1/2" fussy cut rose squares				
Backing	3-5/8 yds	5-5/8 yds	8-1/2 yds	10-1/2 yds

**Construction:**


This project uses precise 1/4" seams. To test your seam allowance, accurately cut (2) 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles. Stitch them together along the 3" length. At the midpoint, measure across the unit.

It should be exactly 2-1/2" wide. If not, adjust your seam allowance and repeat.

1. Place (2) 3-3/8" squares of Large Star Points face down on two opposite corners of a 6-1/4" square of Background. Draw a diagonal line through the center. Stitch an accurate 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Make (12,24,48,64).



2. Cut the Step 1 units apart on the drawn line and press toward the Large Star Point triangles as shown.




3. Position a 3-3/8" square of Large Star Point right sides together on the Background corner of each Step 2 unit. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Stitch an accurate 1/4" seam along both sides of the drawn line. Make (24,48,96,128).



4. Cut on the drawn line of the Step 3 units, and press toward the Large Star Point. This unit measures 5-1/2" x 3" from raw edge to raw edge. Make (48,96,192,256).



5. Lay out the large stars with the Step 4 units, the 5-1/2" fussy cut squares and the 3" squares of Background. Sew these star together. Make (12,24,48,64).




6. Keeping the diagonals exactly as shown, sew a 2-1/2" square of Small Star Point to each end of the 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" Background. Trim the excess from the ends, and press toward the Small Star Point. Make (31,58,110,144).



7. Watching the angle of the diagonal, stitch a 2-1/2" square of Small Star Point to the upper left corner of 3" x 12-1/2" Background. Trim the excess from the corner and press toward the Small Star Point. Make (14,20,28,32).



8. Watching the angle of the diagonal, stitch a 2-1/2" square of Small Star Point to the upper left corner of 3" x 5" Background. Trim the excess from the corner and press toward the Small Star Point. Make (4,4,4,4).



9. Layout the Stars and sashing, including the 2-1/2" squares of Roses cut from the stripe. The 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces are the sashing. The 3" x 12-1/2" pieces go around the outer edge. The 3" x 5" pieces are in the outer corners.

- Lap - 3 x 4 large stars
- Twin - 4 x 6 large stars
- Queen - 6 x 8 large stars
- King - 8 x 8 large stars

10. Sew the top together. Press gently.

11. Attach the Ornament Stripe Borders. Begin and end at the 1/4" seam allowance at each corner, and leave a 7" miter 'tail' extending.



12. Place a corner to miter on your ironing board, with the border that is lying horizontal extending to the right, and the one that is vertical on top of it and extending up. Fold the top extending border diagonally under and position so it is exactly on top of the one extending to the right. When satisfied it is correct, smash it with the iron.



13. Use a pin or two to hold the mitered corner in place. From the underside, stitch in the pressed crease. Check to see that it's correct and if it is, trim the excess from the seam to 1/4". Press these seams open. Repeat Steps 12-13 for each of the corners to be mitered.



14. Layer your quilt and prepare to quilt your masterpiece. You might like to detail the images.

15. Bind with the 2-1/2 Lace Tonal strips, following the instructions with the Binding Miter Tool. There is also a video demo of this terrific tool at [www.YouTube.com](http://www.YouTube.com)
