

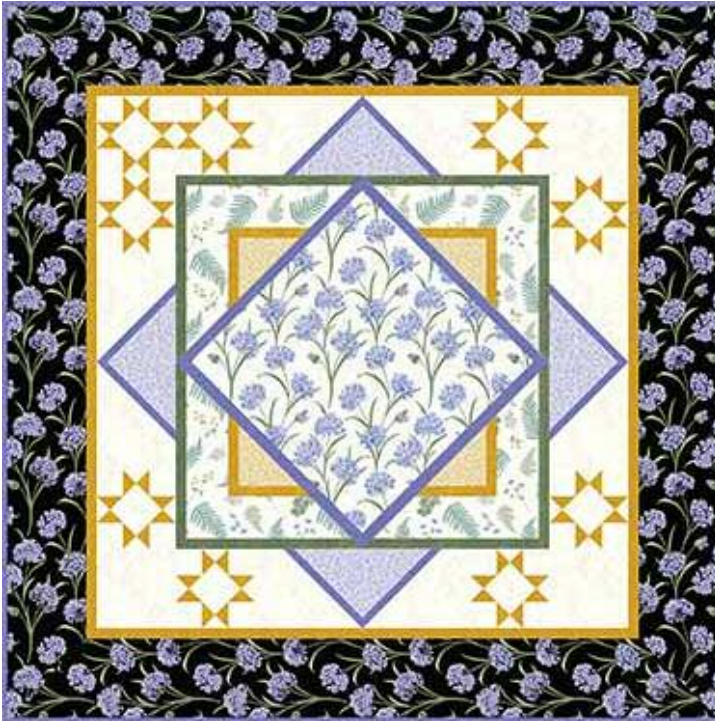

- Ivory Fern Medley - 16228-07 5/8 yd
Cut (4) 4-1/2" strips into:
(4) 4-1/2" x 16-5/8"
(4) 4-1/2" x 12-5/8"
- Med Green Wave Texture - 2966-43 1/4 yd
Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips into:
(4) 1-1/2" x 18-5/8"
(4) 1-1/2" x 17-5/8"
- White Jackie Scroll - 3627-07 1-3/8 yds
Cut (1) 8-3/8" strip into:
(4) 8-3/8" squares
Cut (2) 8" strip into:
(3) 8" squares
(8) 8" x 3-1/4"
Cut (2) 3-3/4" strips into:
(18) 3-3/4" squares
Cut (4) 3" strips into:
(45) 3" squares

Yardage & Cutting:

Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips for Binding

Cut (4) 1-1/2" strips into:

(2) 1-1/2" x 25"

(2) 1-1/2" x 23"

Cut (3) 1-1/4" strips into:

(8) 1-1/4" x 13"

Yellow Whisper Petals - 16230-33 1/4 yd

Cut (1) 6-5/8" strip into:

(2) 6-5/8" squares

Sun Wave Texture - 2966-31 5/8 yd

Cut (2) 3-3/4" strips into:

(18) 3-3/4" squares

Cut (7) 1-1/2" strips into:

(2) 1-1/2" x 53" - piece to create

(2) 1-1/2" x 51" - piece to create

(4) 1-1/2" x 8-5/8"

(4) 1-1/2" x 7-5/8"

Purple Whisper Petals - 16230-63 1/4 yd

Cut (1) 7-3/8" strip into:

(4) 7-3/8" squares

Black Whispering Lilies - 16226-12 2 yds

Cut (4) **VERTICAL** strips 8" x 72"

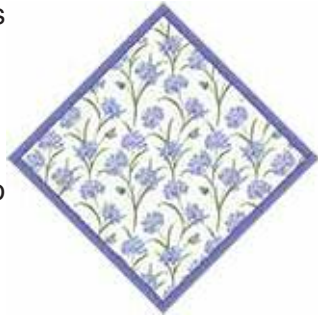
Construction:

This project uses precise 1/4" seams. To test your seam allowance, accurately cut (2) 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles. Stitch them together along the 3" length. Measure across the unit. It should be exactly 2-1/2" wide. If not, adjust your seam and repeat.

1. Cut a 32-1/4" square of Ivory Whispering Lilies. Find the center on each side and cut, creating a 23" 'on point' square.



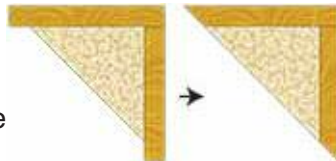
2. Stitch the 1-1/2" x 23" Iris Wave Texture strips to two opposite sides of the Step 1 square. Then attach the 1-1/2" x 25" Iris Wave Texture to the remaining two opposite sides. Press the seams toward the Iris. It measures 25" square from raw edge to raw edge.



3. Cut the (2) 6-5/8" squares of Yellow Whisper Petals diagonally, creating (4) triangles.



4. Stitch a 1-1/2" x 7-5/8" Sun Wave Texture along the side of a Step 3 Triangle. Be gentle because of the bias along the edge that does not receive a strip. Press toward the strip. Then attach a 1-1/2" x 8-5/8" Sun Wave Texture across the upper edge, pressing toward the strip. Carefully trim the edges to match the diagonal. Make 4.



5. As in Step 4, attach a 4-1/2" x 12-5/8" Ivory Fern Medley along the right edge of Step 4, followed by a 4-1/2" x 16-5/8" Ivory Fern Medley across the top. Seams direct toward the Fern Medley. Diagonally trim as before. Make 4.



6. Repeat the Steps 4 & 5 process using 1-1/2" x 17-5/8" Med Green Wave Texture along the right and 1-1/2" x 18-5/8" Med Green Wave Texture across the top. Make 4.



7. Stitch a Step 6 unit to each side of the Step 2 center. In doing so, the diagonal ends will extend about 1/4" so they will meet and overlap at the purple corners. It will now be 36" square from raw edge to raw edge.



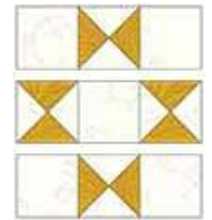
8. Cut the 3-3/4" squares of Sun Wave Texture and White Jackie Scroll diagonally in fourths, like an 'X'



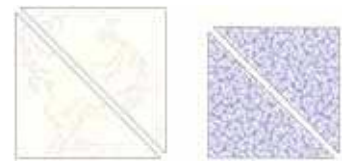
9. Stitch a triangle of each color together. Be consistent. Then sew two halves together to make Star Point Units. Make 36. They measure 3" square from raw edge to raw edge.



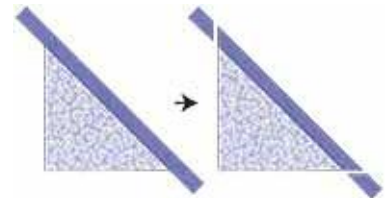
10. Assemble the stars using the Step 9 Star Point units plus 3" squares of White Jackie Scroll. Make 9. They measure 8" square from raw edge to raw edge.



11. Cut the (4) 8-3/8" squares of White Jackie Scroll and the (4) 7-3/8" squares of Purple Whisper Petals diagonally in half.



12. Attach a 1-1/4" x 13" Iris Wave Texture along the long bias edge of the Purple Whisper Petals. Center it, and take care to not stretch the bias. Make 8. Gently press half toward the Wave Texture and the other half toward the Petals. Trim the ends to follow the diagonal.



13. Sew a Step 11 White triangle to each of the Step 12 units. Step 11 is the perfect size, if you need to wiggle the placement a bit. Press the seam toward the Purple Wave or away from it, depending on how it was pressed in Step 12. They measure 8" square from raw edge to raw edge.



14. Stitch two oppositely pressed Step 13 units together. Make 4. They are 8" x 15-1/2" from raw edge to raw edge.



15. Assemble four sets of Step 10 Star, 3-1/4" x 8" White Jackie Scroll, Step 14 unit, 3-1/4" x 8" White Jackie Scroll, and Step 10 Star. Press gently.



16. Attach 2 of the Step 15 units to opposite sides of the quilt. Add an 8" square of White Jackie Scroll or the remaining star to the ends of the remaining two units, as shown, and stitch them to the quilt. It measures 51" square from raw edge to raw edge.



17. Sew the 1-1/2" x 51" Sun Wave Texture to two opposite sides of the quilt. Add the 1-1/2" x 53" Sun Wave Texture to the remaining two sides. Press gently. It now measures 53" square from raw edge to raw edge.

18. Attach the Black Whispering Lilies **vertical** borders. Begin and end at the 1/4" seam allowance at each corner, and leave a 9" miter 'tail' extending.

19. Place a corner to miter on your ironing board, with the border that is lying horizontal extending to the right, and the one that is vertical on top of it and extending up. Fold the top extending border diagonally under and position so it is exactly on top of the one extending to the right. Once you are satisfied that the miter is correct, smash it with the iron.



20. Use a pin or two to hold the mitered corner in place. From the underside, stitch in the pressed crease. Check to see that it's correct and if it is, trim the excess from the seam to 1/4". Press these seams open. Repeat Steps 19-20 for each of the corners to be mitered.



21. Layer your quilt and prepare to quilt your masterpiece. We suggest outlining the star shapes, outline the Flowers and Ferns in the blocks and in the Border, and add a nice swirly quilting to the remaining areas.

22.. Bind with the 2-1/2 strips specified, following the instructions with the Binding Miter Tool. There is also a video demo of this terrific tool at [YouTube.com](https://www.youtube.com)
